Keynote Speaker: Dr. Abigail Gewirtz

Dr. Abigail Gewirtz is a child psychologist, leading expert on families under stress, mother of four, and the author of *When the World Feels Like a Scary Place*, published by Workman in July, 2020. Dr. Abi is a Lindahl Leadership Professor in the Department of Family Social Science and the Institute of Child Development at the University of Minnesota, where she has devoted her career to developing and testing award-winning, skills-based parenting programs that promote children's resilience.

PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

1. You will need contact information such as phone number and email for all presenters.
2. Authors/presenters should include a brief bio that outlines areas of research interest, occupation, roles served in family science, educational attainment, and any other relevant information. This should not exceed 100 words.
3. Your submission should include a brief abstract of your presentation. This should include introductory information on the project and should not exceed 500 words.
4. You should also outline the length of time needed to present and what form of presentation is desired. You may choose from poster, round table, workshop, etc.
